As many of you know, I recently returned from Uganda, Africa. I'm not going to share much here (you'll have to wait until April 14th for all the details), but I wanted to write about the most important thing I encountered in Uganda: hope. For many families in Uganda, their lives are a story of struggle, rejection, and hopelessness. However, the story I heard from every person we interviewed was one of hope found through the work of Forgotten Children Worldwide (FCW) as they have acted as the hands and feet of Jesus. I think we sometimes wonder about the impact of financially supporting organizations like FCW. Is it really changing anything? I can assure you, what FCW does for children and families changes the trajectory of their lives. They are given a hope that will not disappoint them but will lead them to God's love, a caring community, and a brighter future. The joy and faith I witnessed in the people I met was inspiring.
